

EleventySeven, Group 1 Crew to join Freedom Experience Fall Tour

(Nashville, TN) – The Freedom Experience has announced that this fall it will be joined by bands Eleventyseven and Group 1 Crew as it makes its third annual fall tour. “We’ve always said ‘Go big or go home’,” says FX director Scott Crews. “Well...we just went even bigger.”

Punk rock band Eleventyseven recently released their CD “Land of Fake Believe” on Flicker/Sony Records. Their songs “More than a Revolution” and “MySpace” are currently being played on radio stations across the country.

Group 1 Crew, an Orlando-based hip-hop group, recently signed with Fervent/Word Records. They are currently recording their debut album, which is expected to be released this fall.

The Freedom Experience (FX) features illusionist Brock Gill, who has been featured on Fox News, ABC, NBC, and the AP, among hundreds of other print and television media. Gill performs over 200 shows annually, drawing hundreds of thousands of people. He was recently featured on the BBC/Discovery Channel special “Miracles of Jesus,” where he explored and attempted to re-create the miracles performed by Jesus Christ.

The 2006 FX Fall tour will be making four stops across the US this fall: August 28-30 in Palm Coast, FL; September 25-27 in Hattiesburg, MS; October 23-25 in Williamston, NC; and November 6-8 in Prattville, AL.

Also joining Brock at FX is BMX stunt team Chaos on Wheels. A fundamental part of Freedom Experience, Chaos on Wheels has brought their high-flying acrobatics to the event since its creation. Gill commented, “In creating the event, we wanted to combine things that teens are interested in. Illusions. Extreme sports. Music. It just makes sense.”

Only at FX, Brock does his signature escape: the water coffin. “We took a coffin, cut holes in the sides to see in, put Plexiglas in it and filled it up with water. We take locks and chains from people in the community. They chain me up, lock me in, and see if I’ll escape.”

Also new for 2006 only at FX Brock is doing his newest grand stunt: The Bullet Catch. It is the illusion that 13 people have died trying to perform; Brock will attempt to catch a bullet, fired from a gun, in his mouth. One attendee who witnessed the Bullet Catch at the FX in New Castle, KY this past April commented, “It blew my mind when he did it. Better my mind than his, though.”
